Sky Med Plans

SkyMed BASIC PLAN

1. Hospital-to-Hospital Emergency Air Transpor

Medically equipped air ambulance transportation by fixed-wing aircraft, and we also make the arrangements. Ground ambulance to and from each hospital is included.

4.Transportation for Recuperation

After being discharged from the hospital, we will transport the member to his/her residence to recuperate at hom

7. Physical Remains Return

Should an injury or illness result in a member's death, we will provide for transportation of the member's remains to the US or Canada. Transportation of the spouse/companion and the vehicle return service is provided.

10.Incidental Expense Allowance

We will pay up to \$200 usd for incidental expenses associated with a member's medical flight.

2. Vehicle & Vessel Return

Professional drivers for over-land, safe return of operable vehicles (autos, RVs, towed vehicles, motorcycles, trucks) and vessels.

5.Commercial Carrier Medical Escort

We make the arrangements and pay for the private care of a nurse escort when the member is not permitted to travel as a regular passenger on a commercial flight.

8.Escort Transportation

Member's spouse/companion to accompany patient in flight on a private air ambulance, when space is permitted, but if not, we will pay for air transportation for one person.

11.Organ Retrieval

Should a member require a kidney, heart, lung, liver, or pancreas transplant, we will transport the donor organ to them. Individuals on transplant recipient lists at the time of the application are ineligible for SkyMed Membership.

3. Visitor Transportation

Round trip transportation on a commercial flight for a family member or companion to be flown to the hospitalized patient.

6.Minor Children /Grandchildren

If as a result of a critical illness or injury, a member's minor children or grandchildren (up to 19 years old), end up stranded, we will provide for the transportation and a companion attendant, if necessary, to return them home.

9. Return Transportation after recovery

We leave a window open for 60 days after the hospital release date, in the event of having complications and the patient needs to get back to the hospital

12.Organ Recipient Transportation

When it is more feasible to bring the member recipient to the donor organ, we will provide air transportation for the recipient and one family member. A nine month restriction applies to new member eligibility in organ retrieval and this service.

SkyMed ULTIMATE PLAN

13.Primary Driver Disability (PDDO)

This service increases the protection of our traditional vehicle return (#2 on this list). The PDDO provides additional service for drivers who may become incapacitated but have not suffered a critical illness or injury.

14a.SkyMed PLUS

This is a 24-a-day multi-lingual help line that also offers translation services, emergency messaging, insurance verification, travel locator service and more to enhance our SkyMed TAKES YOU HOME logo. It also includes two commercial coach return tickets to origin of evacuation.

14b. SkyMed Xpat PLUS

It also provides for the return of member's pets by commercial carrier, that is a round trip coach air fare for a person to accompany the pets or the choice of a round trip commercial coach ticket from a US or Canadian destination for family member or friend to pet sit while member is hospitalized.

15.100 Mile Waiver

Member can choose to have SkyMed services 24/7/365 when they are at home and while traveling! Our services normally take effect when you are more than 100 miles from home.

16.Helicopter Return

This service covers the cost of the helicopter flight from the scene of a vehicle accident to the nearest hospital, hospital-to-hospital helicopter transport and all medically necessary helicopter transports. First response emergency helicopter flights do not need prior approval, other medically necessary helicopter transport must be arranged directly by Skymed.

18.GLOBAL Emergency Travel Services

Worldwide evacuation and medically necessary repatriation traveling outside the 32 SkyMed basic service area.

17.Ground Ambulance

We pay for the cost of a medically necessary ground ambulance due to a critical illness or injury, not related to the service provide when in an air evacuation procedure. Option limited to two ambulance services per year.
